



APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

The undersigned, having familiarized itself with the provisions of the Objects and By-Laws, hereby applies for membership in CONSTRUCTION LABOUR RELATIONS - AN ALBERTA ASSOCIATION with all rights, privileges and obligations granted or imposed by the Objects and By-Laws. If this application is accepted by the Association, the undersigned agrees to pay to the Association the application fee and all dues, fees and assessments levied in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws of the Association. Subject to the acceptance of this application for membership, and in meeting the requirements of the Objects and By-Laws of the Association, the undersigned agrees:

- a) To forthwith assign to the Association for the member's entire period of membership, the member's right to bargain collectively with Trade Unions in respect of all the trades in which it employs persons in Alberta except those specifically excluded by the By-Laws, or by order of the Directors, and hereby exclusively authorizes and appoints the Association as its exclusive agent during the continuation of the membership of the undersigned in the Association, to bargain collectively on the undersigned's behalf, and in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws to enter into a Collective Agreement, or Collective Agreements, or other undertaking or contracts with a trade union, or trade unions, with reference to the employment of labour, in such terms as the Association considers proper, and to amend, vary, modify, cancel or terminate same;
- b) To irrevocably authorize the Association to perform any acts on behalf of the undersigned concerning contract observance disputes, or any matter arising under the Alberta Labour Act or other applicable Statute of the Province of Alberta relating to Labour Relations;

and the undersigned agrees that excepting as permitted below, it will not perform on its own behalf, or authorize or appoint any person, firm or corporation to perform any of the aforesaid matters or things.

2. The assignment and appointments by the undersigned are qualified as follows:

- a) In the event that the undersigned applicant is a member of another Association to which the applicant has assigned it bargaining rights, it is understood and agreed that the assignment of bargaining rights provided herein, under Paragraph 1(a) above, shall be postponed until the other Association either disbands or transfers its bargaining rights to CONSTRUCTION LABOUR RELATIONS - AN ALBERTA ASSOCIATION, when the requirement of Paragraph 1(a) shall immediately become effective for all purposes;
- b) Nothing contained in the appointment made under Paragraph 1(a) above shall restrict or limit the undersigned from dealing with, settling or handling contract observance disputes arising under any Collective Agreement to which the undersigned is bound:

provided that any such dispute that may effect or relate to the interpretation (exclusive of the application, operation or alleged violation) of a Collective Agreement must be brought to the attention of the Association prior to the undersigned finally dealing with the same, and wherever feasible shall be handled and dealt with in accordance with the agreement reached between the member and the Association.

The undersigned agrees that it will execute further Collective Bargaining Authorizations from time to time in favor of the Association, as may be considered by it to be necessary.
