Rapid Site Access Program (RSAP) Update

Re: Shell participation for maintenance at Scotford, www.rsap.ca re-development, and summary of participating trades

We are pleased to report Shell has given notice they anticipate participating in RSAP on the Scotford Project in respect to maintenance in the first quarter of 2010. RSAP participating sites are as follows:

Note: With the amount of upcoming shutdowns and maintenance work we feel the industry would benefit from the participation of more maintenance sites. Also, we ask that any owners planning major construction work who are not yet participating, contact Sam Kemble to get more information on the program.

Work is underway on the redevelopment of www.rsap.ca and the second week of December looks promising for a re-launch of the system. In spite of the system being down, many trades have supported the program by manually uploading dispatch information to the RSAP providers. In doing so, those trades have facilitated confirmation of Active Status at the time of dispatch, and enabled the RSAP providers to conduct the random testing. Case Management of those in aftercare has carried on for participating trades uninterrupted, and was not affected by shutting down www.rsap.ca.

I am pleased to report that the Sheet Metal and Sheeters, Deckers and Cladders are now capable of dispatching members as RSAP participants. Since May, the Sheet Metal and Sheeters, Deckers and Cladders have participated fully in the mandatory third party case management program.
